Dear Mr. Heinen,

Thank you for your reception report we recieved from you recently. The log you submitted with your report verifies that you indeed were monitoring our new 50kw Superstation on 8 October 1990 at 0350 UTC.

KVEG (not to be confussed with any other station previously using the same call letters) operates with a power of 50,000 watts daytime and 25,000 watts nighttime on an assigned frequency of 840 Khz. Our pattern consists of two major lobes at 0° and 212° from the transmitter location near Apex, Nevada. The same directional pattern is used for both daytime and nighttime utilizing a four tower parallelogram array.

Your reception report verifies, in part, that our nighttime coverage is consisrently good throughout all the western states, including areas of Canada. We also verified reports from as far away as Sweden and New Zealand. Again, we appreciate your informing us of your reception of KVEG, the Las Vegas Sports Station.
