This is to verify your reception of Radio Station WHCU ~~FM~~ AM
Ithaca, New York on 9 January 1966 at 10:25A EST

WHCU-AM operates on 870Kcs with 5000 watts of power on a "daytime" schedule. Sign-on is at New York sunrise while sign-off is at New Orleans sunset. WHCU-FM operates at 97.3mcs with 40,000 watts ERP. The transmitter site is atop Mount Pleasant 7 miles east of Ithaca. WHCU-AM uses an RCA BTA-5 5000 watts transmitter while WHCU-FM uses a Collins 830-F 10,000 watts transmitter. The common antenna tower is an overall 350 feet some 1700 feet above sea level.

Ithaca is located in South-Central New York State at the Southern end of Cayuga Lake. Ithaca, with a population of better than 30,000, is the home of CORNELL University and Ithaca College.

WHCU-AM and WHCU-FM are owned and operated by CORNELL University affiliated with the CBS Radio Network and serving the Finger Lakes Region and Central New York State for more than 30 years.
