Dear Wayne:

A poet once wrote about the best laid plans of mice and men. However, as of now, I have 14 reports in addition to yours. The list is attached and I'm working on getting verifications in the mail. Every person we heard from, with one exception, mentioned the tone tester. And one said he thought it might have been WKBO, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Since the mail moves a little slowly in this part of the country, I expect more reports through the week. However, I'm willing to run another special at the time you suggested, if you think we'll be able to do better.

As to your report, we did run a code I-D at 3:00 A-M, but the tone test which followed that must have been from another station. We did not run any variable tone. Our code I-D was at 2000 cycles.

You've asked a couple of times about our frequency checks. They run the third Wednesday of every month, 5:00 to 5:15 A-M, Eastern Time, standard or daylight as in effect in New York State.

Something else that you and your fellow D-X-er's might be interested in. Approval has been granted for us to increase daytime power to one kilowatt. When our new transmitter arrives and is installed, we'll be running early morning program tests on it. This will probably be in February. I'll let you know as soon as we can set a date.

Again, on the January 17th test, we'll run one if you want us to. So just let me know.
