Mr. Heinen,

This confirms your reception report for WCKY Cincinnati for 2105-2107 EDT on 10 October 2005.

WCKY has been around since at least the 1930s, and held those calls on 1530 KHz except for the past few years when for the purposes of ownership change the calls of WCKY, WSAI, and WKRC were shuffled around. As of this year, everything's back where it originated. The night pattern switches in at California sunset in order to protect a station out in Bakersfield; at the time you were listening it would still have been nondirectional.
