Thank you for your reception report from Aurora, CO on December 27, 1996, from 6:51AM until 7:15 AM EST., it has been confirmed.

WTAM, known to listeners as AM 1100, operates 24 hours daily on 110 kHz. We broadcast a format of news and talk programs, and are one of approximately 25 class 1-A clear-channel radio stations in the United States, broadcasting with a 50,000-watt non-directional signal. We are known as the station that is heard in at least 38 states and 1/2 of Canada.

WTAM has been on the air since 1923, although between 1972 and July 29 of this year it was known by a series of different call signs, including WKYC, KYW and WWWE (3WE). We are owned by Secret Communications of Cincinnati, Ohio.

AM 1100 is an affiliate of the ABC Radio Network. We are also the home of Cleveland Cavaliers basketball.

We thank you again for writing, and hope you will have the chance to tune in AM 1100 again in the future.
