
Dear Sir:

I am very pleased to report reception of KTLQ on 1-23-81 from Midnight until 12:11am CST on your assigned frequency of 1350 kHz. At this time KTLQ was conducting frequency tests. At midnight I tuned into tone on 1350 kHz and nulled semi local KIDN in Pueblo CO. to obtain the best signal on KTLQ. This was fair at the best. At 12:03am there was an ID " This is KTLQ, Tahlequah Oklahoma. It is now three minutes after 12 o'clock.. more was said but lost under KIDN... then more tone resumed. at 12:06am another ID was given " This is KTLQ Tahlequah Oklahoma it is now six minutes after 12 o'clock , January 23, 1981,... and fade under KIDN. then tone resumed a short time later. at 12:11am the tone left and nothing was heard after that.

I was using a Navy surplus WWII receiver with a 15" ferrite core loop antenna. I'm located on the near north side of downtown Colorado Springs. For your information I've been a BCB DX'er since 1964, since 1975 from Colorado Springs. I am 30 years old, married and a real estate appraiser for the local assessor.

Please find enclosed return postage for your convenience, also a brochure on the BCB DX'ing hobby. I would appreciate a verification from KTLQ to add to my collection if this report is found correct. Thank you in advance for your time and trouble in answering this report and helping me with my hobby.
