Many thanks for your report on the reception of our station.

CJRH, located in Richmond Hill, Ontario first broadcast on the assigned frequency of 1300 kcs. on July 1st, 1957, with a limited broadcast schedule from sunrise to sunset and used an omni-direction radiation pattern.

On March 20th, 1959, we began broadcasting twenty-four hours a day with a power output of 1000 watts on a daytime pattern and 250 watts output on the night time pattern, on the assigned frequency of 1310 kcs.

On October 13th, 1961, we were granted a further power increase to 10,000 watts daytime, 2500 watts night time. At this time we also changed our letter to CFGM.

We are live as a Richmond Hill Station with a Greater Metropolitan Toronto coverage.

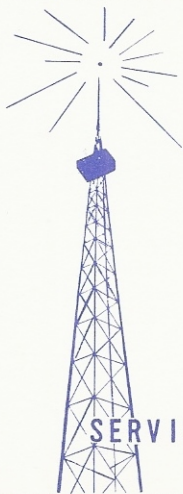
We appreciate reports from listening posts such as yours and wish you continued success in the field of service.
