We're pleased to verify your CHLO reception report of November 5th.


Thanks for providing the details which made this possible.

We're also glad that you persisted until you found our signal on 680.

As to CHLO and 1570 khz., yes, we presently have an application for a move to this frequency. If approved, CHLO would operate with a day/night power of 10 kw. Both our present and proposed patterns have a north/south orientation. If use of 1570 khz. is approved, we would lose some of our present coverage and listenership at a distance, but gain a more solid home service area signal and eliminate several sharp nulls in the home area that we presently live with.
