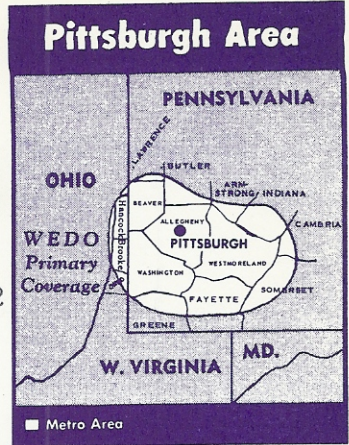

Dear Mr. Heinen:

This is to verify your reception of WEDO between 12:09 and 12:20 on March 26, 1967.

I was a bit surprised to hear from a DX-er as close to Schenectady as you are, until I read of your use of a loop to null out WGY, as they come in here with a lot of power as soon as we're off the air.

We have a Gates kilowatt transmitter, driven by a symmetrically operated Raytheon limiter. This is fed from the studio by a CBS Audimax (compressor) which is needed because the board is run by the announcer, and the levels aren't always as they should be. By keeping our modulation up all the time, we try to make up for the lack of carrier power.

I've enclosed a lot of literature that I think might interest you. Thanks for the letter, and good luck with future DX-ing.
