This letter confirms your reception of KTOQ radio on January 16, 1980 from 1:00 to 1:12 AM MST. Your reception report on our 1340 kHz signal is very much appreciated.

KTOQ runs 1 kW day & 250 W night nondirectional. Our transmitter is a Harris MW-1A and it feeds a 300' folded unipole antenna.

I do engineering for several of the radio stations in Rapid City and the surrounding area...so I am quite familiar with the other stations that you have heard around these parts. I may very well have written your confirmation on KIMM. If it wasn't me, it probably was Bruce Bradfield, one of my partners in crime!
