
Dear Wayne,

We are pleased to confirm your reception of KZMX at 580 kHz. We actually consider ourselves an Easy Listening station but our format does contain some Country music. We broadcast with a power of only 500 watts daytime with a Harris MW-1 transmitter. We have received several DX'er letters from your area. Our signal seems to carry very well to the south as our half millivolt contour is over 100 miles from the studios.

KZMX has just enlisted the services on Vir James engineering of Denver to prepare application for raising the power of KZMX AM to 1 kw. KZMX, originally KOBH was started in 1958 and was granted a CP for 1kw. However, a distant station on an adjacent channel threatened to file a lawsuit against KOBH for feared interference. The KOBH founders chose not to take the risk and proposed a modified CP for 500 watts. We expect no problems with this power raise and would like to involve you in the promotion of our power raise. We would notify you of the exact date of the increase and would like to call you and have you give a confirmation of reception on the air. Obviously, this increase will be several months distant, but if you would be interested please send a note.

Thank you for writing and be sure to tune us in again sometime.
