Dear Mr. Heinen:

This letter will confirm your reception of Radio Station KIKR on 880 kHz. on January 5, 1986 from 12:02 AM to 12:33 AM.

KIKR began operation in 1951 and operated on 900 kHz. with a power of 500 Watts daytime only. On April 7, 1984 KIKR switched to our completely new transmitter facilities and began operating on 880 kHz. with the Daytime power of 10 KW and Nighttime power of 1 KW. We have different antenna pattern Day and Night. All of our transmitter equipment is new with the exception of a third backup transmitter. KIKR uses a Harris MW-10A transmitter Daytime and a Harris SX-1 transmitter at Night. We also have a Collins 20V-3 1 KW transmitter as a backup to either transmitter. We use a two tower directional system in the Daytime pattern and three towers in the Nighttime Pattern.

At the time you monitored the station we were playing Rock music, that was only for a brief period and then we went back to our Country format. KIKR has always been a country music station except for about six weeks when they tried the rock format.

I am enclosing a bumper sticker and a coverage map of KIKR.
