Thank you very much for your recent letter reporting the reception of KIUN in Pecos, Texas.

I checked our program logs for December 15, 1988, I am pleased to verify your reception. We aired a 60-second public service announcement for Pecos Valley Crimestoppers at 6:34am during our "Southwest Daybreak" program.

I have enclosed a KIUN bumper sticker to add to your collection! If you get down this way, stop by and visit us. KIUN went on the air in 1935, and at that time was the only station between Ft. Worth and El Paso on the T & P Railroad. In the early days, when there were very few 1400 KHz stations, KIUN received many listener responses from all over the country--as far away as Hawaii. A few years ago, I received a letter from a gentleman in Australia reporting reception of our station, which really amazed me. He was a DX'er like yourself.

KIUN is 1kw (day and night) and programs primarily country & western music. We're a "hometown station" with lots of local news & sports coverage. We also feature about 25-hours weekly in Spanish-language programming. KIUN is an affiliate of the Texas State Network and carries the Dallas Cowboys each Fall.
