This letter confirms your reception of KNRB on the morning of March 19, 1991. Distance from our transmitter to your location is 625 miles. I very much appreciate your signal report.


The station operates 5kw omni day and 1kw directional night. Main transmitter is a Nautel AMPFET-5 5kw total solid state transmitter operated at 1kw for night. Auxilliary transmitter is a 1939 model Raytheon RA-1000. The Nautel measures 25"w X 27"d X 78"h. Transmission facilities are just outside of Carswell AFB's east gate since 1946.
