I must apologize for the slowness of my reply. The reason is that I just started as Chief Engineer for KTEO-AM and KWLW-FM on 11/14/77 and the last two weeks have been rather wild trying to get everything working around the place. I was living in Salida, Colo. until about 10/15/77 and after we sold our TV repair business there (to a fellow from Colo. Springs by the way ) we decided to come down here since we had lived here several years ago.

At any rate, everyone here at the station was quite impressed with your DX report and we are certainly happy to confirm and verify your report for your own collection.

KTEO-AM is currently running a Collins 820D-1 , 1000 Watts days and 250 Watts nights, on the air 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We use a Rust Corp. Remote Control system and a Gates Compressor/Limiter. We are Non-Directional with a single tower 190 feet high.

Thanks again for your fine report Wayne and listen for us again.
