I am very pleased to report reception of KTRN on 1290 kHz on 11/20/77 from 2:14a until 2:25a CST. Your signal here was fair with QRM from KOIL in Nebraska and much slop over from local KVOR on 1300. The following are the details of my reception:

2:14a Middle of the Road Inst. music
2:16a P.S.A. for First United Methodist Church of
Wichita Falls
2:17a USPS Mail early P.S.A. then song by Firefall
2:20a KTRN mentioned by announcer then into more music
2:25a More music.

I've heard snatches of KTRN but never enough for a report before. Usually KVOR destroys both 1310 and 1290. I DX with a WWII surplus receiver and a 4' loop antenna. I've received over 625 verifications from 49 states and 25 foreign countries.
