5:20 PM "Traveling back in time all day every day Classic Country 1470" and Spot for Beaver (?) Liquor Store 105 North Washington "or call 672-1331"
4:21 PM Spot for The Country Flea Market at 4061 West Lake Road call 473-4550
4:22 PM Spot for Patio rooms by Battle's Home Improvements
"We Love the Classics as much as you do, we're Classic Country 1470" and more music

This is a tentative report as I didn't hear a call, or even a city however the Classic Country format, antenna direction and the pattern/power change around 5:40 or so would indicate KYYW. Last verified as KEAN back in 2003 when I caught KEAN running non directional with reduced power per the letter I received from Chief Engineer Gary Smith.

Equipment in use while listening to KYYW consisted of a Drake R8B Communication receiver with a variety of indoor and outdoor antennas. By trade I'm a real estate appraiser and have been a BCB DX'er since 1964. Please find enclosed return postage to facilitate your reply and a brochure about the BCB DX hobby and The National Radio Club.

If my report is found correct I'd appreciate a verification from KYYW to add to my collection from over 1800 BCB stations. Thank you in advance for your time and consideration in answering this report and helping me with my hobby.
