Dear Wayne:

This letter is to confirm your reception of KJQN on 1490 Khz on 1/7/80. We operate, as do most of our fellow Class IV stations, with 1000 watts day and 250 watts night using a non directional 1/4 wave antenna.

I regret that we do not have any QSL cards to send you, but with 250 watts, it didn't seem necessary. Recently, though, we have been receiving quite a number of DX reports, and it is good to know the signal is getting out. In the near future, we hope to change to a 5/8 wave antenna, which will make DXing more difficult, but it will keep more signal here on the ground.
