- 7:28 AM Teasers for 7:50 newscast and more C&W music.
- 7:31 AM DJ is Larry Jay and into KMTI Community Bulletin Board.

This is my third report to KMTI over the years, one for each frequency 1340, 1590 and now 650! Your station may get reports from further east at sunrise as KUUY in Cheyenne recently went silent. This allowed my clear reception today.

Equipment in use while listening to KMTI consisted of a R-390A/URR Army surplus receiver with a 4' box loop antenna. By trade I'm a real estate appraiser and have been a BCB DX'er since 1964. Please find enclosed return postage to facilitate your reply.
