
Dear Mr. Heinen:

Please accept my apologies for the extraordinary length of time between this reply and your reception report dated November 26, 1983! Since coming aboard in December of last year, my time has been completely devoted to rewiring two control rooms with new audio consoles, installing new production equipment and attempting to make some of our older equipment operational.

Your reception details match closely with the information recorded on the program log of November 21, 1983. Therefore, your reception of K o J O broadcasting on 1490 kHz has been verified.

This July 15 is the target date for completing construction of our new AM transmitter facilities. We will broadcast at 1210 kHz with 10,000 watts of power. If you can hear us this fall, send another reception report. I will try to get the QSL out much quicker next time.
