I am very pleased to report reception of KUUY on 1530 kHz on 1-18-80 from 11:50pm- 12:00am MST. Your signal was good to fair with some QRM from KFBK in Sacramento. I would like to offer the following details of your broadcast as proof of this reception:

11:50pm C&W song " Mr. Bojangles"
11:54pm Time Check DJ John Ramsey on 10,000 watt K- Double U- Y and more country music
11:57pm Straight to Willie Nelson C&W song
12:00am K Double U Y.. KUUY Cheyenne now completes another day of broadcasting KUUY operates on 1530 kHz with a power of 10,000 watts daytime non-directional and directional 5000 watts critical hours and 1000 watts nighttime... and off

KUUY is not really that strong here. Skipover from KOMA prevents reception with my longwire, I was using my 15" ferrite core loop antenna with a Navy surplus WWII receiver during this reception. I'm located on the north edge of downtown Colorado Sp rings 6 blocks East of I-25 on the Uintah exit. Elevation 6600'.

I've considered writing in regards to the National Radio Club Courtesy programs committee. Many of our members need KUUY for their DX logs. Each year dozens of stations present special TEST broadcasts in conjunction with our club, these usally combine maintenance testing and DX'er enthusiasim to create an interesting bond between the two. If you would be interested in a test program I will be happy to help arrange one.
