We gladly verify your reception of Radio for Peace International (RFPI) on/at:

The output power was 2 KW.

We intend to increase the power as soon as possible. Our operational schedule beginning November 1, 1988 will be 21.560 MHz (modified) from 2100 - 0000 UTC, 13.660 MHz from 0100 - 0400 UTC and a broadcast to Central America in Spanish on 7.375 MHz from 1400 - 1700 UTC.

Enclosed is information on RFPI as well as the program schedule and RFPI's QSL card.

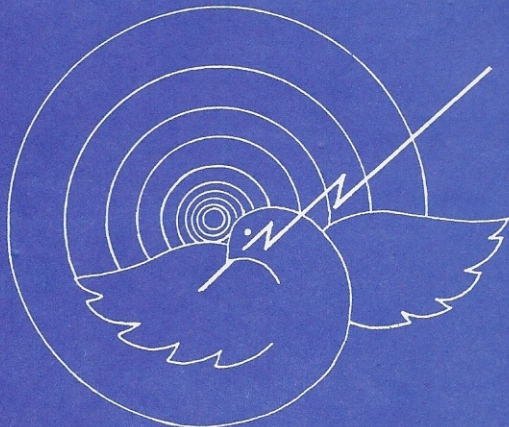
