I wish to verify your reception report of may 9,1953

and to thank you for your nice letter.

I believe yours is the first letter we have had since we have been on the air with our program test we've had reports during our equipment test but you

caught us during a frequency test.

I would like to tell you a little about our equipment here at WOZK, We use a Collins 20-V l kw transmitter working into a 50 ohm transmission line into a shunt fed tower. The tower is a stainless 245 guyed job. With 120 ground radials 437 ft. long, plus a copper screen around the base of the tower and under the slant wire.

We operate daytime only with a non directional

antenna.
