I am pleased to report that your report of reception of April 3, 1949 checks with our program log of that time. This was during our regular scheduled program and your report from 11:45 to 12:00 our time Saturday is correct.

It seems strange that you have not heard our frequency checks as they have always been made from 1:00 to 1:15 AM MST, and our last one, April 4th brought reports from Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Toronto to mention some.

We operate on a fulltime power of 1000 watts and employ a two tower directional array at night. Our equipment is W.E. and seems to be doing a nice job. Our transmitter site is north west of Coolidge near the Casa Grande National Monument, with our studios in downtown Coolidge.
