Dear Mr. Brauner:-

This will acknowledge your letter of December 17th. I believe it was dated, wish to thank you for the nice report you sent me, I played you a record the other night on our DX program, and I have a letter from Kenneth Page, of Silver Creek, N. Y. to-day he says you are well known in Dx circles in his parts, this lad send a good report this week.

Well I have not done much with the transmitter for the last eight or nine months, times are to darn hard and I don't have the pep, by the way I have my application in to Move this station to Fort Collins, Colo a city of 11,486 people with about 38,000 within eight miles of the stations towers, this city is located about 140 miles north-west mostly west of Yuma, within 12 miles of the Mountains, going to use 110 ft towers and cage T-type antenna and Counter-poise system, counter-poise right-angles with antenna.

I am not sure when the permit will be granted, but expect it most any day now, I don't know if you will be able to pick me up or not, of course Collins is East of the Mountains and its some higher then Yuma, there no station there, and the businessmen are nuts to have me move and they been doing every thing in there power to see that I get there, expect to run about six hours a day there and of course will run a DX program, by the way when you write me again let me know the best nights for DX on the 1200 Kc Band and we will try to run them on that night, it seems that every body wants to run on the hours I am on now and the night also.

Well I must sign-off as I have a lot of work to-do as I am packing my shop equipment.
