

Thank you for your detailed report of January 27th, reporting reception of our DX test on that morning. Your further comment on the clarity and strength of our signal is also noted, and is deeply appreciated.

We note your reference to 7XYZ interfering with reception from this station during our regular broadcasting hours, and in this connection would point out that we have replies from several parts of New York State that report just the opposite, that is that we blanket 7XYZ. Frankly, therefore, it seems to be a fight between the two of us for coverage in New York State, but since we are considerably further away than VXYZ, we feel that we are doing very good under the circumstances.

It is not likely that we will be putting on DX tests for some time to come, which is a resumption of our previous policy to refuse DX test broadcasting, because of the improbability of a clear channel and the very early hours of the morning we have to go on the air.
