40 some letters on the boxes one over 85 came in.

10.B.P. is a Hartley with tuning
modulation. we are permitted to couple direct to ant
so get good radiation about (2 1/4 amps) two 210's
oscillators 3-250 modulators 600 on plate. 210's
have 400 on plate. I may have told you that before
I forget. I belong to A.R.R.I. but do no brass
pounding as I do not know code. tell me what your
code stands for. I mean in your letter you mention
signal strength ASA 4 to 5. modulation R.F. I take it
modulation rounded like 80% but I do not know
ASA values. although I built 10.B.P. completely
I know very little about radio. I am alone in
my business which is 90% radio. so as far as
10.B.P. goes I do most everything myself. on OX
