
Thank you for your fine report on our reception report of Oct. 10., it is proving very helpful to us here to us from the engineering standpoint.

Being a new station it is quite trying at first to get everything operating as efficiently as possible but we are doing our best to satisfy our listeners.

We are operating at 100 watts output at the present time but expect to be increasing that very shortly to possibly a kilowatt. The equipment is RcA throughout and we are using a quarter-wave-length tower (vertical) shunt-fed with an A mphenol transmission line. As time progresses and the availability of equipment becomes more adequate we will be adding to our station.
