Dear J.W. Brauner,

Thanks ever so much for your very fine report of reception of our DX Program of Dec. 6th. This is to VARIFY your report as correct.

The sudden drop-outs might be explained by some unmodulated carriers coming on and off during this program. WPAT and WSAZ were both testing and causing trouble. You see, if their carrier was strong enough to operate the AVC in your receiver its sensitivity would be suddenly reduced while this stronger carrier was on. It has been very interesting to study your report along with over 50 others and make an analysis of the test. The NRC promises to publish a summary report which I plan to make so that all you fellows across the country can see how our signal fared with others.

I tape recorded the entire program a few days prior to the DX morn so that all I had to do that cold and snowy morning was to put the transmitter on the air and let the tape go. I sat back with a cigar and "enjoyed" the program myself.
