16 miles West of Lisbon, facing the Atlantic Ocean, is the Europe's most Westerly Broadcasting Station.

The transmitter with an aerial power of 5 kw 100 % modulated, is located in a building specially erected to that effect which comprises also two studios, one of them 44 feet long by 24 feet wide, library, workshop and premises for the personnel. The aerial, of the vertical type, is suspended between two steel towers 200 feet high and 617 feet apart.

In the park adjoining the station, there are two lawn-tennis courts, basket and volley-ball, hockey and skating rinks for the member's use.

The transmitter has been entirely designed and built by Portuguese Amateurs members of the Club.
