Thanks for the very complete report on reception of WAAC on the morning 11th. I appreciate the fact that we have a report from your direction since I have wondered what WJW did to us up that way. We do not operate 24 hours, only 18 and the broadcast you heard was our regular frequency check program that is on every second wednesday morning from 3:50 to 4:00 A.M. --- I presume the signals that you heard after 4:00 was some other station on the same frequency which was probably was on for frequency check. ---

As for the ~~rd~~ frequency we were measured at 3:55 A.M. 3 cycles high --Your report is most complete and we would appreciate any others you may wish to send in. We do not have any QSL'S but hope this letter will fit into your files.
