This letter and the enclosed card will serve to verify your reports of reception dated April 26, 1948 from 2:37 AM EST to 3:50 AM EST and on November 11th from 2:03 AM to 2:05 AM.

We're very sorry your other letter wasn't answered, but there was a great deal of confusion here in getting the station on the air.

Our equipment is exclusively Collins except for RCA turntables and General Radio freq. and mod. monitors. We have a 240 foot Stainless, triangular section, guyed, vertical radiator. The ground system consists of 6 miles of #10 copper wire buried in salt water (Indian River).

I wish to thank you very much for writing and giving us your report of reception and apologize once again for not having answered your last letter.
