Dear Mr. Brauner:

We wish to verify your reception of our station during the broadcast of a test program from 2:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m. Central Standard time. This was our very first time on the air, and hence we were very much gratified to know that we were getting out so well.

WKEU has a power of 100 watts on a frequency of 1,500 kcs. We are using 2 -- 203A's in the final stage modulated with the new Class "B" system. Our antenna system is also of a type which has not as yet found many broadcast applications.

We have checked the notations in your letter with our log and find that you must have had the program continuously while you were listening.
