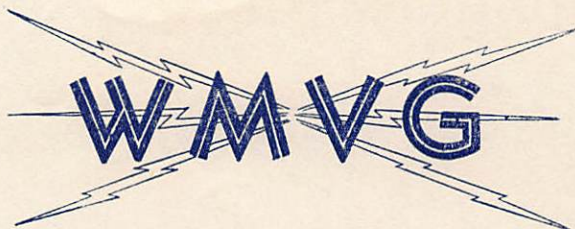

Dear Mr. Brauner,

This is to berify your very interesting report of reception of WMVG on March 23, 1946, which I find to be correct according to my Station log. March 23rd was our first time on the air. We began equipment tests at 1.05 AM. EST. of this date. The interruptions you mentioned were due to frequency checks or adjustments rather being made . We adjusted both crystals to 1450 kc. with FCC recognized monitoring service in Atlanta, Ga. Evidently he was not getting us as well as you were. The interruptions were at his request, by phone, to help distinguish our signal.
