It is indeed a great pleasure to receive your very interesting letter of Nov. 25, 1954. You can rest assured I am amazed to hear that you are receiving WRPB in Valier, Pa. You see, my wife and I both are from Western Pa., New Kensington, in fact, and while I am not sure where Valier is located, I do know where Punxsutawney is, as my father has lived on W. Mahoning Ave. in Punxsutawney for the last 3 years. So you can see I was amazed to learn that we are putting an S6 signal into Buffalo, New York, and happy to hear from you. While we were home over Labor Day, we visited Punxsutawney and then drove to Buffalo on some business. It's somewhat of a delight to hear that we are reaching out so far.

WRPB is being very well received by the people of Middle Georgia. We are the only station in Middle Georgia that is programming almost solely pop and sweet music all day long. From 5:45 to 6:00 A.M. is the only Hillbillie Music we have.

We use Collins equipment, throughout, with a stainless 200 foot guyed tower with a ground system of 120 hard drawn copper wire radials 200 feet long, located 2.4 miles outside the City Limits of Warner Robins.

We have had various letters from all over the South and Southeast. We've had others from Pennsylvania, but listing only late at night and very early A.M. testing schedules. We've heard from Ohio, Indiana, Massachusetts, and New York, and believe me, we really appreciate each one. May we thank you again for the interest shown in our station.

Your log checks of the week of Nov. 15, to 22nd, and of the 23rd, 24th and 25th of November, 1954, checks with our logs of those dates. Keep listening for us and please do let us know if you have better luck at picking us up in the future. Thank you for so kindly enclosing a stamp for our convenience in answering your letter.
