Dear Mr. Brauner,

Thank you for your reception report of Oct. 31. Yes, we were on for a freq. check 1:01 to 1:17, the last break was at 1:1620, which was the one you received. Previous to that I had been using 1000, 800, and 500 cycle tones with breaks about every three min.

We are using an RCA BTA 250L transmitter loaded to 100 watts and a 150 foot self supporting tower. Our ground system consists of 120 radials 175 feet long and 120 50 foot radials.

Our regular freq. checks to Commerical Radio Monitoring Co. in Kansas City are held the last Sat. each month, 1:00 to 1:15 AM. We would be happy to hear from you again.
