
Dear Sir;

This will serve as verification of the reception of our signals Oct. 6 at 6:00 AM EST and also on Oct. 11, 45 6:00 to 6:42 AM EST.

We were very glad to hear of your reception of our station on the above dates and even more suprised to learn that they were heard as well as RB. I might tell you that the morning of the 5th we retuned our ant. before going on the air which is probably the reason for your recieving us since then. The Ant. by the way is a quarter wavelength vertical the transmitter an ordinary 250 watt composite with high level modulation. The morning of the 11th I noticed your leter of the 6th on the control room desk and thought I better get busy and write him a letter---- maybe he's listening this morning so was careful to keep the modulation up as close to 100% as possible maybe it helped I don't know.

Thank you for your kind letters we would appreciate hearing from you whenever you find the time.
