Dear Friend:

Knowing you have "listened in" on the programs of W-M-B-I station - and having received either by letter or telephone an expression of your commendation of this ministry over the air, it occurs to the management to lay before you some facts about the Moody Bible Institute which sponsors this station.

The booklet enclosed will give a brief picture of the founding of the Institute and how the work has grown throughout the forty-two year period since it was established and a concrete example of the result of the work of the students in the social life of Chicago.

The fiscal year of the Institute will close April 30th. There has been a large enrolment of more than 2200 students during the year and it will require \$100,000 to meet all current obligations.

The Institute has but a slight amount of productive endowment and must depend, as it has done for more than forty years, on voluntary gifts to provide free training to the qualified students who come.

Believing you would like to help make possible the training of students and sending the gospel message and Bible teaching to the thousands of shut-ins and others, and hoping that you could suggest to us the names of friends who might become interested in this work if they knew more about it, we are enclosing a blank asking that you give it careful consideration. If the Moody Bible Institute has been the means of bringing God's blessing into your life, you can greatly help in carrying this blessing to others by a gift at this time of real emergency.
