Dear Mr. Brauner:

This letter is in acknowledgment of your letter of the twenty-first. Your observations of our program material and announcements on that date show that you were in reception of our signal. The transmitter here is a home-made job. We are running a pair of 810's in the final with a pair of 805's in the final audio stage. Our antenna is a series fed narrow tapered steel mast 175 feet tall. Our radiating system is located atop the Fort Wayne National Building which gives us an overall height of 375 feet. The ground system is 125 square feet of 1 square foot copper mesh. Needless to say, your reception was quite out of the ordinary considering the numerous stations on the same frequency. You were probably getting us on about the third or fourth skip. We will be on at the same time next month, so you might be listening in ! Thanking you for your interest, I am -----
