The new site for WGRC is working out fine although our DX reports have not been as numerous as in the past. We are using the same antenna as was used at the old location and our sky wave should be approximately the same strength as formerly, so perhaps the weather conditions account for the difference. We are also using the same transmitter, an RCA ET 4250.
