Dear Mr. Brauner:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 23rd, and confirm your report of reception of WGFG on Tuesday, September 23, 1947, 1:10 pm, est, on 1360 kcs.

You will probably be interested in knowing that WGFG began its first full day of broadcasting on August 8th, 1947. It is a 1000 watt ABC affiliate. At the studio we use RCA turntables and pickups, and RCA speech equipment. The transmitter is a Raytheon RA-1000 located $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles northeast of Kalamazoo...and the antenna phasing equipment is Johnson. We use a directional antenna consisting of four 300-foot Blaw-Know towers. Our directional pattern is such as to protect Green Bay, Wisconsin, Hartford, Conn., and Cincinnati, Ohio.

We appreciate your report and thank you for your interest in our signal.
