Your information about the excellent reception of our programs of February 14 and February 19 is highly appreciated. We seem to get unusual results for a 100 watt station when we have a clear channel, but we should, since our transmitter is the latest type manufactured by RCA Victor and has exactly the same characteristics as their installation of WEAJ in New York, with the exception of a 'slight' difference in power.
