Dear Mr Brauner:

I am very pleased to have your fine report of last Tuesday's DX program. I feel that even though you have logged our station before, you should have a letter of verification on this program which I am enclosing.

I have been very pleased at the response of the National Radio Club as we have heard from 16 states in spite of the interference from a half dozen all-ni ters on 1230 kc. and one unidentified station running a tone test.

I have been especially interested in the pattern of field strength which I have been able to gather from the reports. There is one block just next to the antenna block which is located almost in the center of Lapeer that has been brought unintentionally by the addition of garages and apartment wiring into unison with the 1230 kc. capacity and have suspected for some time it was absorbing a good deal of our field strength in that direction. That block is on the side of the station toward Chicago and the listeners in Indiana and Illinois without knowing of this problem have confirmed my suspicions that while our field strength pattern has been nearly circular, it has recently been reduced in that direction by this strange situation in the adjoining block.

The listeners who furnished us with this detailed information on our field strength in that direction have rendered us a great service.

I was especially pleased by your reference to the evening service of more than 25 years ago.
