Dear Mr. Brauner:

We wish to verify reception of election program on Nov. 4th, referred to in your letter of the 5th.

The reason for your not being notified of this program was that at the time we went on the air we had no intention of staying on at such a late hour. We are doing a little remodeling and as soon as it is completed we expect to go on the air with some tests, at which time you will be notified.

We note that you say we came in with more volume than KGDE at Fergus Falls. KGDE is using 250 watts. However, they are not using a high percentage of modulation as yet. We use a 50 watts transmitter, using the last stage of radio frequency with a 250 watts modulating tube, which undoubtedly accounts for the greater volume.

We wish to thank you again for your report and hope that you will be able to pick us up on our future DX programs.
