WCOG was on the air continuously for thirty hours broadcasting a final program, signing off at six o'clock, Saturday afternoon, May 18th; as this station is moving from Columbus to Meridian, Mississippi, and will be on the air again within thirty to sixty days with an increase from 500 to 1,000 watts, but same wave length of 340.7 meters or 880 kilocycles and call letters WCOG.
