Dear Mr. Brauner:

This is to acknowledge receipt with thanks of your very nice letter of Feb. 17th. Letters like yours make up for all the other obscure and ambiguous "reports" that come in all the time. I sincerely appreciate your letter, and all the information that you give me and which is of so much value and of interest to a new station.

We started operations on Nove. 18th last year ---or about 90 days ago with 100 watts, and have been increasing power as more elec. power was made available to us. We are now running between 8 an 10 Kw. output into a 1/2 vertical radiator. We hope to run 50 Kw. Doherty with 2-862 tubes before the end of this month if we get delivery of the tubes, and install another diesel-elec. plant we are working on at present. We have to generate all our own power, and if the noise of the plants doesn't leak into the studio, then the ground vibration usually does---but we hope to over come all these problems that are allways different with different installations.

We have no pictures of the station, nor cards, nor office ---yet; we will though, in the future, and maybe 2 or 3 months from now, when we are finally organised, and you write us again, I may have a picture to send you.

Your report is correct on the reception, and please accept this letter as a verification.
