Your report of reception of WBBO on January 3 was complete enough to enable me to verify your reception.

The program you heard was local news, read by Glenn James, the editor of the Spindale Sun, published in Spindale, N.C. two miles west of Forest City.

WBBO is located on highway 74, mid-way between Forest City and Spindale. Transmitter and studios are in one of the most modern buildings in this section.

Our transmitter is a composite job, converted to broadcast from an AFRS transmitter. The tower is a 300 foot Wincahrger. We operate daytime only, with a power of 1000 watts.

Reports such as yours are always of interest to me, and I hope that you will try to receive us again.
