Thank you for your report of reception of WCNC on September 23. It is correct. At that time we were on equipment test. We are now on regular schedule from seven AM until eleven PM EST.

We are using a Western Electric 310 B transmitter, 23 B speech console, 110 A peak limiting amplifier, salt shaker microphones and RCA turntables. Our antenna is a Blaw-Knox one hundred seventy five feet high.

Elizabeth City is a town of about fifteen thousand population, located in the Albemarle district of northeastern North Carolina, about twenty five miles from the Atlantic coast.
