Do you have any regularly scheduled early morning test or check period?

Do you use such remarks like "The KB weather forecast". The reason I ask this last is because this evening, Monday Oct, 26th. at 5:30 PM I heard a 1500 Kcs. station use this remark.

The signal was bothered too much by WTOP to permit definite reading. But that remark was quite clearly heard (forecast was lost in interference.) There is no other 'KB' call on 1500.

Station signed off at 5:45, which I happen to know is the Oct. sunset time for your city. WTOP is mighty strong up here in west-central Pa. (70 miles N,NE of Pittsburgh) but I have heard WEAC in Gaffney, S.C. several times, both AM & PM through them and will keep trying, maybe get WKBX clear sometime too.
