Dear Mr. Brauner:

At the present time, the nation's most modern cellophane plant is being constructed at Ecusta.

You certainly heard our station on both occasions July 1, 1950 and December 28, 1950. Naturally I am amazed that our 250 Watter gets out so far. The next time we test we shall try to let you know in advance and dedicate a number to you on the broadcast.

Again, let me apologize for the belated reply and say that we hope you enjoy using the fine Ecusta paper.
